Sovereignty Is Logic You Control

Embed AI decision logic at the tactical edge, under full national control.

## Redesign Procurement

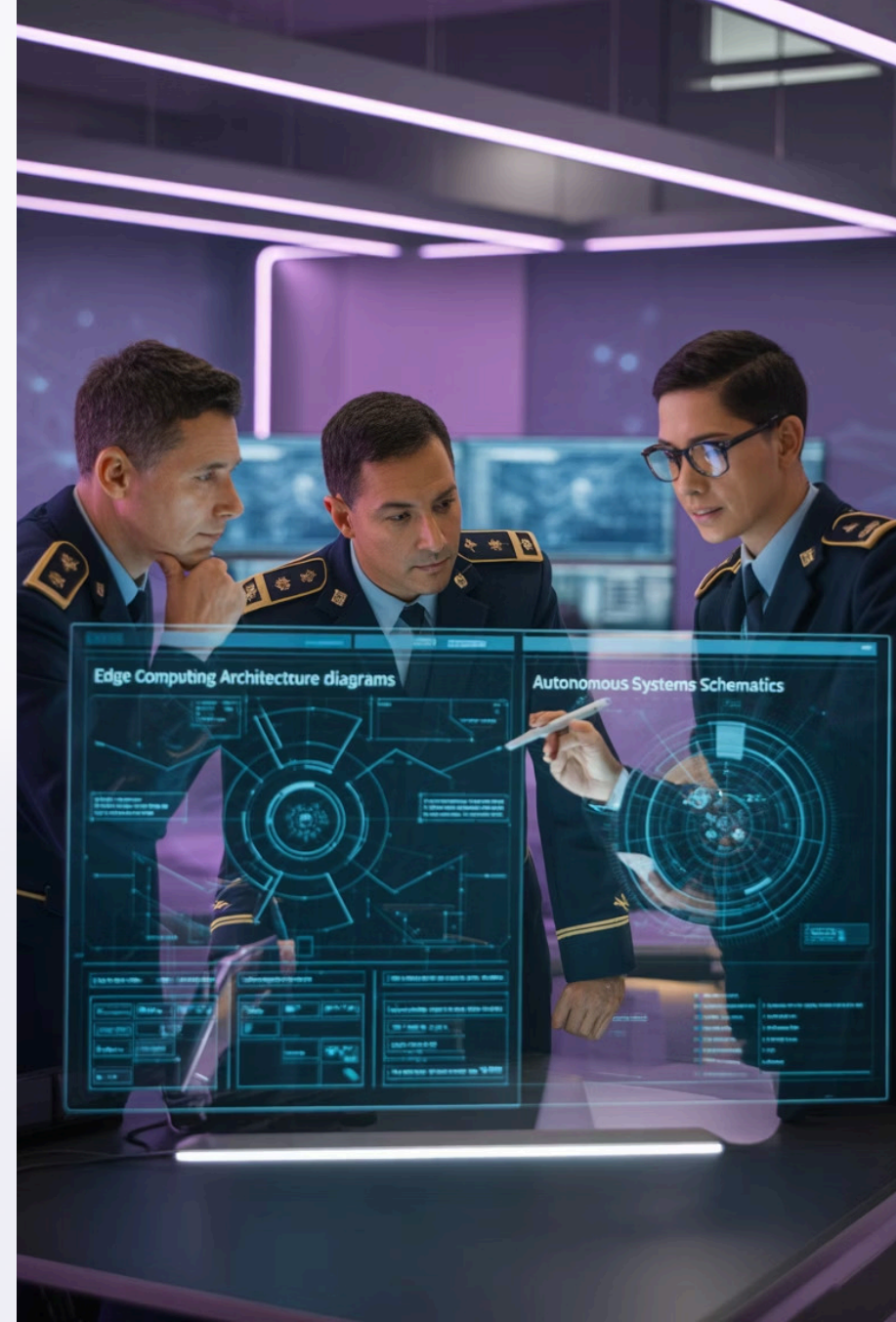
Redesign procurement frameworks to require auditable, sovereign-aligned AI systems.

## End Remote Dependence

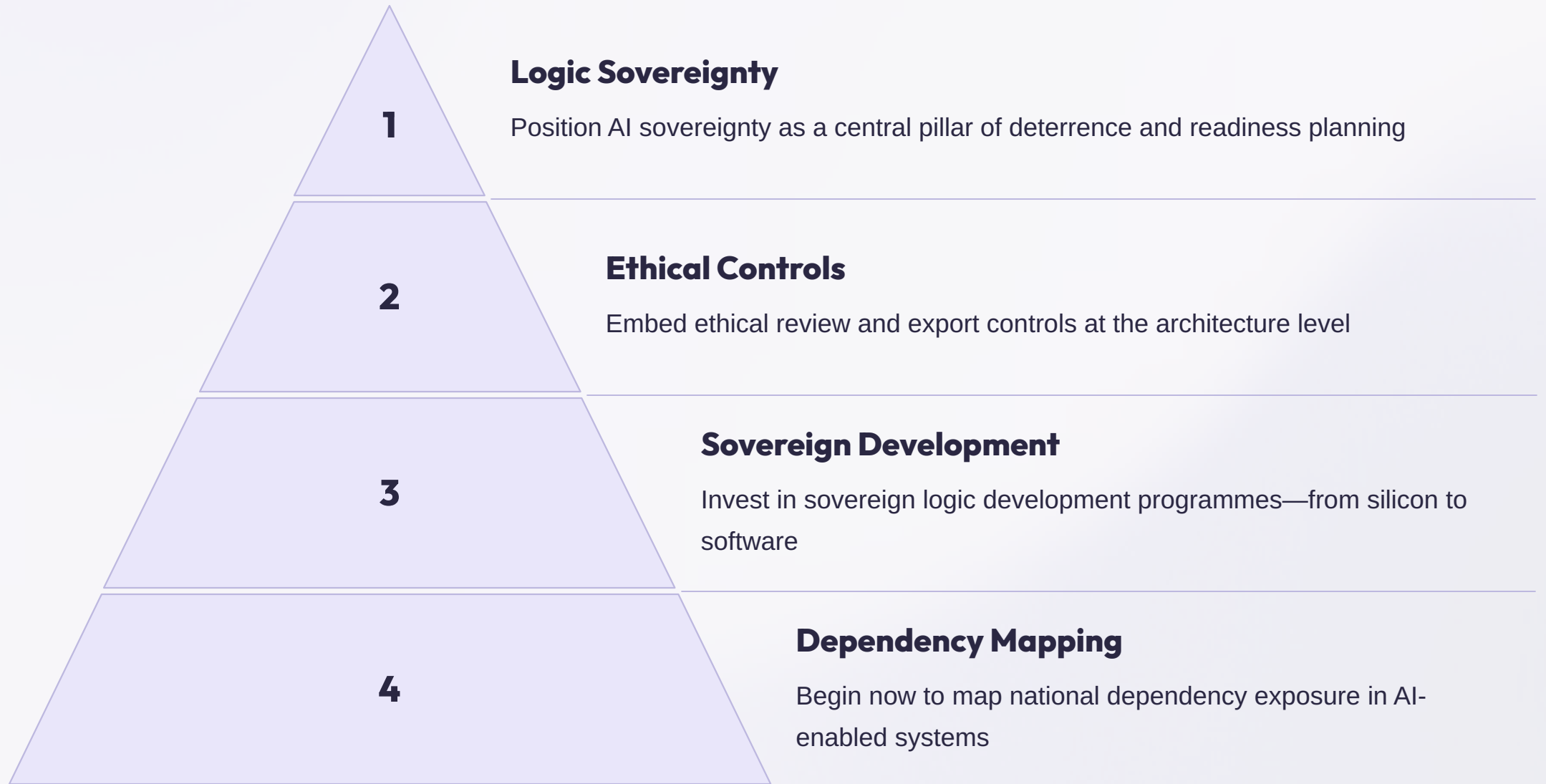
End reliance on remote AI infrastructure for mission-critical tasks.

## Protect Sovereign Logic
